### **What are the goals of *Stewards of Children*?**

- Inform adults about the facts regarding sexual abuse in America
- Increase awareness of possible situations in which sexual abuse could occur
- Teach simple and effective strategies for protecting children from sexual predators
- Instruct adults on how to educate children and others on the prevention of sexual abuse
- Train adults to recognize signs of sexual abuse, react responsibly, and intervene accordingly
